The professorship is embedded into the Physics Department. The successful candidate shall participate in the teaching courses of the Physics Department. Independent research activities in the framework of the research of the Institute for Astronomy and Astrophysics are expected as well as the implementation and interpretation of multiwavelength observational programs at space-based observatories and experimental developments for future space missions. Furthermore, participation in the research activities of the Kepler Center is expected.

The candidate will have a completed study and an excellent PhD in the relative subject and an internationally competitive publication record.
