About the book:

Overseeing the frothing ocean and dangerous pirates near the world's end in the Roman itinerarium, the Vembanad lake beckoned the world with spices. Her embankments hosted Muziris-'the primary emporium of India' in the global trade along the aromatic, maritime Silk Roads by the dawn of the Common Era. This inter-continental entrepot brought various ethnicities ashore, making it a cultural gateway to the rest of the world. The Vembanad towns of today hold India's oldest Judaic, Christian, Islamic and European settlements. The endemic knowledge of the native Dravidian communities, and indigenous flora and fauna nestled by the global biodiversity hotspot-the Western Ghats, revolutionised agriculture along these basins. Vembanad's fragile and fertile river basins are home to the "Kuttanad Below Sea Level Farming System"- one of the three Globally Important Agricultural Heritage Systems (GIAHS) in India as per the Food and Agriculture Organisation of the United Nations. Sustaining the economic nerve centre of the state- Kochi, and providing the lifeline to three districts- Ernakulam, Kottayam, and Alappuzha, Vembanad embankments are home to 8.58 million people with a population density of 1250 persons/ km^2 in its lowlands. With exponential usage of a dynamic and delicate water system, including the construction of Wellington island- India's largest, artificial island, Vembanad is being heavily deformed under tremendous anthropogenic pressure.

"The Vembanad" looks at how human geography has evolved around its waters for over three millennia skewing the biodiversity and water dynamics of the region.
