Lecture/Repetitorium: Students can acquire 1 ECTS for participation and 6 ECTS if they chose either a 30 minute oral exam or a 4 hour in-class exam

Proseminar: Seminar for students in their first and second year. They introduce students to rather more circumscribed topics, theories, methods and to how to write research papers, they allow for 7 ECTS, include a 90 minute in-class exam and a 15 page research paper

Hauptseminar: Seminar for students in their third and fourth year, include a mixture of BA and MA students, rather larger topics, students can earn 9 ECTS by taking a 4 hour in-class exam or by writing a 25 page research paper

Übung: These vary quite a bit, from reading sources, studying methods, developments in historiography, etc. Students usually have to present on a topic in these classes to acquire 4 ECTS
