- Speakers will be given <u>co-host rights</u> and thus be able to share their presentation. Please make sure to change your laptop/PC settings accordingly, if necessary.

## Information for scientific workshop contributions:

- Each working group will be led by a person (chair) appointed by the conference team. This person will be responsible for the running of the session and in particular to ensure that the time limits for the contributions are maintained.

- Posters should be submitted in two formats:
  - 1) As pdf-document (in a format from DIN A0 to DIN A4, landscape and portrait format possible) and
  - 2) as a max. two-minute video in which the poster is presented (we recommend commenting on a PowerPoint slide).
