A Brief Introduction to the History of Methodism

- The Methodist movement was founded by the Anglican priest John Wesley (1703–91).
- Strict rules (bible reading, prayer, fasting etc.) and social commitment (visiting prisoners, education programs, micro credits etc.).
- The movement was nicknamed "Methodists".

Confirmation Work	Kirchlicher Unterricht / Course of Christian education
Confirmation	"Einsegnung" / reception of an individual blessing, >> remain affiliated (baptized) members
	"Gliederaufnahme" / confirmation >> reception as full (professing) members of the worldwide UMC










Increasing Interest in Specific Methodist Topics (t1+t2)






Attitudes toward the EmK (t1 – t2)

scale: 1 – 7; mean




Three key findings concerning workers in Confirmation Work

- 85% of the workers like to do CW
- 69% of the workers are satisfied with their CW
- Teamwork increases satisfaction of confirmands and workers









The Logitudinal Study (t1 – t2 – t3)


- learning more about God and faith

The Logitudinal Study (t1 – t2 – t3)

- ——C/K/QE08 (parents rather/very religious): In difficult situations my faith in God helps me.
- ——C/K/QE08 (parents less/not at all religious): In difficult situations my faith in God helps me.
- C/K/QE09 (parents rather/very religious): I believe in God.
- C/K/QE09 (parents less/not at all religious): I believe in God.





Summary

- Confirmation Work in the EmK is in high regard (adolescents & workers).
- High potential of CW for adolescents (faith development, voluntary work etc.)
- Minority situation fosters an intrinsic motivation for CW and a personal interest for questions of faith and methodist identity.



Challenges

- How can the Church support the adolescents' faith development after Einsegnung?
- How can the Church support Christian education in families?
- How can CW and Youth Work be linked up more efficiently?
- How can the Church involve more teamers in CW?



Central Conference (2017): Resolutions

- Adolescents can contribute to church work (internships, projects etc.)
- Adolescents can contribute to worship services (style, issues, culture etc.)
- Adolescents are to be encouraged to become full members of the EmK



Central Conference (2017): Resolutions

- KU an Youth Work will be linked more closely
- KU is a task of the congregation as a whole, it is generally led by a team, including young confirmed volunteers
- KU includes camps with 3+ overnight stays
- Adolescents can propose topics, their questions of faith are going to be adressed
