Content & Objectives:

This master-level course presents a unified framework in which tax policy and its consequences can be analyzed. We introduce basic concepts used in public economics and some fundamentals of economic modeling. Beside theoretical approaches, it will also be demonstrated how theoretical work has influenced empirical research by discussing recent research papers from the field. These research papers will be studied in a tutorial. I will upload lecture slides, a script, and research papers on ILIAS (on a weekly basis).

- 9. Taxes and International Profit Shifting
