

# alma Portal Role: Student

How to register for / deregister from TRACS exams

## Status: July 2022

## 1 How can I register for TRACS exams in the alma portal?

### 1.1 What is new?

Registering for examinations of the Transdisciplinary Course Program and Career Service (TRACS<sup>1</sup>) is possible in alma for bachelor students since the summer semester 2022. Achievements in TRACS are generally non-assessed coursework (no grades assigned); for better readability, however, we will refer to all TRACS achievements in this document as "exams".

## 1.1.1 Preliminary consideration

First of all, you need to know in which section within the courses of the Transdisciplinary Course Program and Career Service (TRACS) your course is listed, e.g. Liberal Education, Transferable Skills, Career Service. You will find TRACS in the course catalog in the section Non-Faculty Courses:



Furthermore, you must know how many credit points (CP) you can acquire by successfully completing this course. You can find this information in the course details in the university course catalog.

#### 1.1.2 Procedure

In your "Planner of Studies with Module Plan", you can now register for the corresponding exam. To do so, click on the "+" symbol to open the corresponding category under which your course is listed in the course catalog:



Then register within the specific section via any of the elements that correspond to the credit points you need. There are several elements with the same number of credit points because you will need a new one for each new achievement. Each element can only be used once:




Figure: An offer with 3 credit points was selected here.

After clicking "Apply", you will see the following message:





Figure: Important information on registration and deregistration for the examination.

Check the box "I accept" and click "Next".

After you have read and confirmed the message, you will see all TRACS courses with the required amount of credit points for which you can currently register for the exam.



After clicking "Apply", you will see the following message:





Figure: Status: "admitted" to the TRACS examination Liberal Education / Introduction to Ethics.

You can also deregister ("Sign off") from the exam via your Planner of Studies with Module Plan anytime within the registration period.

Exam registration and deregistration are only possible within these periods. If you do not see the button for registration ("Apply"), this means in many cases that the registration period for this exam has not yet started.

If there is something wrong with your exam registration or your Transcript of Records, please contact the Central Examination Office.
