- Public Economics (Taxation, Fiscal Federalism, Tax Revenue)
- International Business Taxation (Firm Decisions, e.g., Corporate Finance)
- International Economics (Trade, Multinational Enterprises, Economic Integration)
- Development Economics (The Role of Tax Institutions for Economic Development)

But you are also welcome to suggest your own research proposal.
