The Spring School is dedicated to bringing together postgraduate students and academic scholars from various fields and disciplines to discuss their understandings and conceptualizations of participation in media cultures. A focus is being put on theoretical as well as empirical perspectives on studying (mediated) participation in the context of so-called immigration societies. With this, we want to offer a week of dialogue over recent debates on immigration and society in Europe in regards to what participation means and what role media can play.

We now invite applications of (young) researchers from different disciplines whose presence will become a vital part of the Spring School program. The program offers different formats of presentation of ideas and possibilities for dialogue. Participants will be expected to present their own research project during a poster session (posters to be prepared beforehand!) and take part in roundtable discussions on topics linked to the keynote speeches and further topics including media, participation, and civic culture or (feminist) activism or solidarity. The participants will be part of the roundtable discussion that is best suited to their research interests.
