Dr. Eliecer Maluenda, a psychiatrist of the Diaguita Native American nation, was a rescuer in a health brigade during the Chilean social uprising of October 2019. He used his car as an ambulance to transport injured protesters to hospitals and health centers. In January 2020, Chilean police seized his car without a court order. This short ethnographic documentary follows the steps of Dr. Maluenda in the rescue of his ambulance car. Will he succeed?
