Confirmation of person completing work placement

Approximately 2/3 of the student's work placement should consist of work-related tasks, while 1/3 can consist of courses (key qualifications). If the student wishes to credit his/her work contract (student assistant/student trainee) as a work placement, the student has to give evidence in form of a timetable stating that he/she has completed at least 27 days of qualified work.
