## Visit the ERCCT!

The ERCCT provides young scholars with the opportunity to visit our center for different periods of time.

For young scholars from our partner institutions who wish to visit Tuebingen for up to one month, the <u>Visiting Fellow Program</u> offers a stipend of 900.- €, a round-trip plane ticket, and office space at our center. Applications for the summer term 2013 (April 15th to July 27th) are now being accepted, the deadline is 15th February.

For long-term visiting fellows who wish to stay for a longer period of time (minimum six months, maximum 24 months), we also offer <u>a monthly allowance</u> of  $350.- \in$  to cover part of the living expenses. There are not deadlines for applications.

#### Visitors to our Center 2012/13

For the academic winter term 2012/2013, we have invited two visiting fellows to our center. Ms. <u>Chen Yi-Ling 陳奕伶</u> from the Graduate Institute of East Asia Studies (National Cheng-Chi University) arrived here on 20th November and will stay in Tuebingen until 19th December. Chen Yi-Ling is currently working on her dissertation project concerning China's urban governance. Our second visiting fellow for this term, Ms. <u>Tsai Pei-Lun 蔡沛倫</u> from the University of Nottingham, School of Law, will stay with us from 7th January to 5th February 2013. Tsai Pei-Lun is conducting research on her Ph.D. thesis "The Application of International Human Rights Law to Unrecognized Entities: The Case of Taiwan".

Further, we are glad to announce the visit of Dr. Mikael Mattlin from the Finish Institute of International Affairs, who is scheduled to visit Tuebingen in early January in the course of our Visiting Scholars Program.

#### **Our Research Fellows**

Our former Research Fellow, Dr. Wang Hong-Jen 王宏仁, has received his Ph.D. from the Institute of Political Science at Tuebingen University, and has no taken up a position at the University of Duisburg-Essen.
