ERCCT to become CCK Overseas Center

The European Research Center Contemporary Taiwan (ERCCT), established in 2008 by an agreement between the University of Tübingen and the Chiang Ching Kuo Foundation for International Scholarly Exchange, will become a CCK Foundation Overseas Center this year; one of only four such centers worldwide. This decision, taken by the Board of Directors of the CCK Foundation after a thorough review of the ERCCT's performance over the last years, is a milestone for the long-term promotion of European Taiwan Studies and the education of young Taiwan scholars at Ph.D. and postdoc level.

A corresponding agreement between the University of Tübingen and the CCK Foundation will be signed at the occasion of a symposium in Tübingen in early July (see below). With its new status officially granted by July 1st, the ERCCT has taken a major step to secure the continuation of its work in promoting postgraduate social science research on Taiwan and fostering academic dialogue and exchange between European and Taiwanese scholars.

ERCCT to offer Research Fellowships

Beginning in autumn 2014, the ERCCT, in cooperation with the Ministry of Education of the Republic of China (Taiwan), will continue its Research Fellowship Program for doctoral and post-doctoral students specializing in social science-based research on contemporary Taiwan. The scholarship grant, which will be awarded once every year, will comprise a monthly allowance of 1000.- € for a maximum of three years, plus a round-trip air ticket to Taiwan. Successful applicants will also be provided with office space at the ERCCT, and will partake in the academic activities of our center.

Details of the scholarship program will soon be announced on our website.

ERCCT winner of the 2013 French Taiwanese Cultural Award

The ERCCT is honored and delighted to receive the 2013 French Taiwanese Cultural Award, which is granted annually by the Paris-based *Fondation Culturelle Franco-Taïwanaise de l'Académie des Sciences Morales et Politiques* to individuals or institutions who have made a substantial contribution to the understanding and spread of Taiwanese culture. The price money of 25.000 Euros will contribute to financing the numerous ERCCT activities and programs, and will be presented during a ceremony in October in Paris, attended by Taiwan's Minister of Culture, Long Ying-Tai 龍應台, and ERCCT director Prof. Gunter Schubert.
