Contradictory Valuations of Resources

The values and meanings attributed to specific resources can be diverse and sometimes oppositional, even when similar (or identical) resources in the same society are considered. Our workshop, which is designed as a dialogue between social anthropology and archaeology, aims to understand these contradictions by employing a broad perspective on resources that refrains from viewing them merely as means to meet personal needs. This becomes especially clear through the example of LNG (liquefied natural gas), presented by our key-note speaker Marianna Betti. The follow-up discussion, coordinated by Robinson Krämer, will furthermore elaborate this topic by comparing archaeological and social anthropological case studies.
