





Organise your studies with Alma


- Personalise your Home for quick access
- Manage your courses, create a schedule, (de-)register for exams, get examination results, and request reports (e.g., certificate of enrolment)
- Get course information and register for courses





Access lecture material through Ilias


- Place courses on your Dashboard to manage the course material
- Find your courses in the Repository, join, and add them to your Favourites to get quick access through your Dashboard
- Access and download course material, upload exercises, find course colleagues





Stay informed and in contact via Horde


- Access your mailbox and compose new mails
- Create (sub-)folders to manage your mailbox
- Automatically redirect messages to your preferred mail address
- Filter for e.g., bulk messages to easily sort things out





Other exchange platforms: moodle and timms

- Some lecturers use moodle to provide lecture material, conceptualised similar to llias
- Access and download course material, upload exercises
- Video platform timms provides recorded lecture/study material
