Cecilia Malmström

Cecilia Malmström is presently a Nonresident Senior Fellow at the Peterson Institute for International Economics (PIIE), an independent nonprofit, nonpartisan research organization, based in Washington D.C. and dedicated to strengthening prosperity and human welfare in the global economy through expert analysis and practical policy solutions. She is a host of PIIE's Trade Winds biweekly virtual discussion series.

Malmström has devoted the better part of her career to global affairs and international relations and has extensive experience with multilateral leadership and cooperation. She served as European commissioner for trade from 2014 to 2019 and as European commissioner for home affairs from 2010 to 2014. She was first elected as a member of the European Parliament in 1999, serving until 2006, and was minister for EU affairs in the Swedish government from 2006 to 2010. As European commissioner for trade, Malmström represented the European Union in the World Trade Organization (WTO) and other international trade bodies. She was responsible for negotiating bilateral trade agreements with key countries, including agreements with Canada, Japan, Mexico, Singapore, Vietnam, and the four founding Mercosur countries. Malmström holds a PhD in political science from the department of political science of the University of Gothenburg.


