The University of Tübingen Museum (MUT) presents its latest exhibition, Krankheit als Kunst(form) – Moulagen der Medizin (Illness as Art - Medical Moulages) from June 10 - September 11. The show was designed by students in collaboration with the Tübingen dermatology hospital as part of a project to train young curators.

Moulages are wax molds of body parts evincing particular symptoms of a disease. The items on show were made some hundred years ago and were used in teaching medicine. Some of the Tübingen moulages show conditions which no longer exist - or in stages they rarely reach today. Some of the moulages from 1910-36 made by German doctors abroad demonstrate rare tropical diseases.

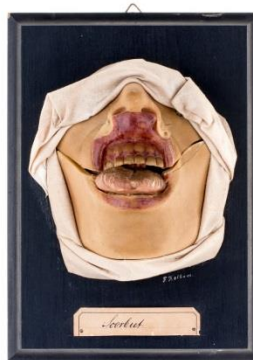
