Globalization puts strains on economies, cultures, and political systems of the world. The scope of its challenges demands solutions beyond the powers of the classical nation-state. Building on common human aspirations and humanistic values and virtues, Otfried Höffe has laid out the theoretical foundations for a world republic - a subsidiary complementary federal world order which ensures the rule of law for a peaceful, and just world.
