

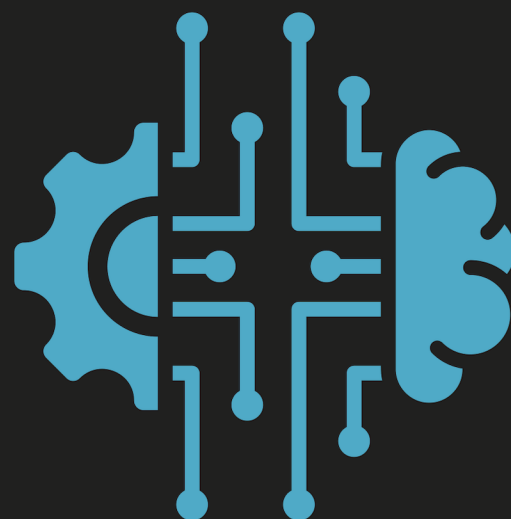


“HUMAN-AI SYMBIOSIS, ALGORITHMS, AND WORK”
