Early Cities and the Evolution of History

Concern about the present and future of modern cities coupled with increased research on ancient cities has led archaeologists to consider how and why ancient cities emerged, flourished, and (in some celebrated cases) collapsed. In a forthcoming edited volume, “Early Cities and Comparative History,” these topics are explored in a global perspective. In this lecture, significant findings depicted in the volume will be discussed, also the history of research on early cities and the meaning of early cities in the past and present.
