„Jomon of Japan: sustainable, resilient, precocious“

The societies that inhabited the Japanese archipelago from the development of the first ceramic containers 16,000 years ago to the appearance of rice farming 2500 years ago, were among the most innovative and creative of prehistoric foragers.

This talk will consider the resources that facilitated the success of the Jomon tradition: from nuts to obsidian, from salmon to clay, and from lacquer to jade. I will also address how archaeologists can develop methodologies for approaching the ways in which these Jomon foragers perceived the environments in which they lived.
