## Public Notice of Selection Process for Postdoctoral Fellowship – FAPESP

<u>Project</u>: Limits and possibilities of the good-living of black students in institutions of higher education. <u>Process FAPESP</u>: 2018/15573-0.

<u>Project objectives</u>: Describe and analyse the well-being of students in higher education institutions, investigating their subjective well-being, the episodes of prejudice and ethnic-racial discrimination in the academic environment, the reception and psychosocial assistance services offered by universities, the forms of student organization and the support offered by their families regarding their studies.

Project leader: Professor Alessandro de Oliveira dos Santos.

<u>Description:</u> Application is open to Brazilians and foreigners and the selected candidate will develop a subproject dedicated, in particular, to the systematization of theoretical and conceptual relations between the notion of good-living, decolonial thinking and policies for the promotion of ethnic-racial equality.

<u>Prerequisites:</u> PhD in the area of human sciences or health; knowledge of the English language; no failures in graduate school transcripts; experience in research groups; proof of acceptance of 02 papers for publication - **article, book chapter or book** - or of 02 papers already published, or even of 01 published paper and 01 paper accepted for publication.

<u>Workload and remuneration:</u> 40 hours per week. Monthly stipend of R\$7.373,10. Duration of 12 months with the possibility of extension up to 24 months according to the applicant's performance. A financial aid (technical reserve) equivalent to 10% of the annual scholarship value will be granted for each year of scholarship, for expenses directly related to research activities. It is also foreseen to grant installation and transportation assistance in case the selected candidate is from outside the municipality of São Paulo or Brazil. ## Selection process:

Phase 1 - Submission of an original text of two pages, in English, on the subject of the project, a copy of the transcript and the certificate of completion of the doctoral degree, address and contact of two people (teachers, researchers, among others) indicated as personal references of the candidate, proof of accepted or published scientific work and curriculum summary in the FAPESP model (<a href="https://www.fapesp.br/en/6351">www.fapesp.br/en/6351</a>) containing the full address, e-mail and telephone.

Phase 2 - Interview for those selected in phase 01 on **09/12/2021** via a scheduled teleconference.
