About the Supervisor(s):	We work at the intersection between biology and psychology, often with a focus on educational psychology. Main foci are birds and teaching & learning in biology, and studies about birdwatchers. I like cooperation across disciplines and boundaries. We use many methods, such as questionnaires, hormone assays, actigraphy, field and lab experiments, and others.
Specification:	Digital tools supporting birdwatching field trips in school and university
Topic Description:	The project will assess the usefulness of digital tools and apps for bird identification during a field trip (e.g., Merlin, eBird, KI supported binoculars (Swarovski Ax-Visio), other applications and tools, such as thermal imaging). The project will be carried out as an experiment in the field following standard protocols (treatment-control group designs) and will assess outcome variables such as learning achievement, motivation, but also psychological restoration and some physiological parameters (e.g., cortisol). Some work will be done in the lab in addition.
