Simona Piattoni is Full Professor of Political Science (Department of Sociology and Social Research) at the University of Trento, Italy. Her main research focus is on democracy in the European Union (both theoretically and empirically), the Committee of the Regions (and its contribution to EU democracy), multi-level governance, and interest representation including the aspects of clientelism, patronage, and corruption. Among her numerous publications are: *The European Union. Democratic Principles and Institutional Architectures in Times of Crisis* (Oxford University Press, 2015); *Shaping EU Policy from Below. EU Democracy and the Committee of the Regions* (Edward Elgar, 2016); *Handbook on Cohesion Policy in the EU* (Edward Elgar, 2016); *The Theory of Multi-Level Governance* (Oxford University Press, 2010). In 2017 Prof. Piattoni was guest lecturer at the Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence PRRIDE at the University of Tübingen.
