




In case of illness, your **first point of contact** is usually not a hospital but a **general practitioner** (GP = Allgemeinmediziner in German). A GP as your standard doctor is also called **Hausarzt** in German. If necessary, the **GP/Hausarzt** will refer you to a **specialist** (Facharzt). If you need a **dentist** or a check-up with e.g. a **gynecologist / ophthalmologist / dermatologist**, you can directly make an appointment with these specialists.

 **In case of an emergency, acute crisis or illness at the weekend / on holidays, see our list of emergency, crisis & medical services!**

HOW TO FIND A DOCTOR

In Germany you are free to choose your medical practitioner. It might be convenient to look for a doctor whom you can easily reach. Regular consultation hours are on workdays.

- 1 Choose a doctor from our medical contact **list of English-speaking doctors**.
- 2 Use the search function on the website **Arztsuche** (search for a doctor):

 - Enter *Tübingen* as "Ort" without any of the postal codes
 - You **do not know German**? Enter in "Erweiterte Suche" *English* into the field "Fremdsprache": Only **English-speaking doctors will be shown** as a result.
 - Click an entry in the results list - you will see the office hours & contact details.
- 3 **Ask your buddy / friends** for a recommendation of a doctor.

HOW TO VISIT A DOCTOR

You need to **make an appointment** before you see the doctor, normally per telephone.

If you have an **acute medical condition**, please mention clearly that it is *acute*: Most likely you get an appointment the same or next day.

- 1 When you see a doctor, take your **health insurance card / proof** and an **ID card** with you.


Students with public health insurance (EHIC etc.): Your insurance card will be used to charge your health insurance company directly.

Students with private health insurance (Mawista etc.): You will receive a receipt of the doctor which you need to pay. Submit it to your health insurance company for reimbursement.

- 2 **Talking to your doctor**: Tell them about your condition.
 - If medication is necessary, you will receive a **prescription** for the pharmacy.
 - If necessary, you will be referred to a **suitable specialist**.

HOW TO GET MEDICATION

- i **Submit the prescription** for your medication to a pharmacy of your choice.
 - **Pay copayments (5 - 10 EUR)** for the medication, if required (**public health insurance = EHIC...**)
 - **Private prescriptions** (Privatrezept = **private health insurance**) must be paid completely by yourself. Submit the private prescription form to your health insurance company for reimbursement.

 Some medications are only available if you have a prescription by a doctor. Other medication can be bought directly in the pharmacy without prescription: These are lighter drugs for problems such as temporary headaches / cough / stomach issues etc.

In case of doubt, please see a doctor!

Emergency / Crisis / Medical Services

For all central emergency numbers (Police, Emergency Medical Care, Poison Control) be prepared to give the following information:

Who you are, where you are, what has happened, how many people are involved. Wait for further questions.

➔ Follow the instructions given on the phone and wait for the arrival of the police / ambulance, if applicable.
