### The use of resources in the Later Prehistory of Central Spain

The aim of this presentation is to present the questions, and the lack of other questions, that are central to the research of recent Prehistory in the interior of the Iberian Peninsula. For a long period of time, the supposed absence of resources led researchers to believe that these regions were not settled. In order to generate theoretical models which defeat these assumptions, it is fundamental to understand the ideology which lies beneath this claimed absence of settlements. On the other hand, it is also necessary to develop methodological protocols which allow us to construct new elements of discussion regarding the sector's resources.

The UAH Department of Prehistory team carries out their research in the area of recent prehistorical funerary archaeology in the southern Meseta. The aim of this strategy is to contribute evidence, originally from funerary contexts, to the world of the living. It is important to mention the exceptional position of this sector, in the area of the Tagus River, which contains some of the most spectacular Chalcolithic sites from the western Peninsula.
