

Success in academic career: How do I become a professor?

Female professors are still the exception.

While women comprise more than half of the student body, their percentage decreases while climbing up the academic career ladder. The last step to professorship is passing successfully a well-structured appointment procedure: the “Berufungsverfahren”. In this workshop we will look on the different stages of the process: the application, the audition lecture and interview with the appointment board, the offer (“Ruf”) and the final negotiations.

Based on the needs of the participants we will also talk about which crucial step can be taken years in advance to plan a successful career in neurosciences.
