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Dear exchange student,

you intend to apply for an exchange semester or a clinical electives at Tübingen University, Faculty of Medicine. We are happy to welcome you to Tübingen!

In order to be admitted to courses with patient contact you will have to prove your immunity against measles (two vaccinations or proof of immunity via antibodies in the blood – see measles immunization form „Certification of the Measles Immunity Status according to §20 (8-14) German Infection Protection Act (Infektionsschutzgesetz - IfSG)“). For this purpose, the form, which must be signed by a doctor, **must be handed in together with your application documents. Without proof of immunization against measles, your application will not be processed further.**

To ensure that you yourself and your patients are protected in the best possible way, we additionally strongly **recommend** the following measures:

1. Hepatitis B
 - Minimum of three vaccinations **AND**
 - Anti-HBs > 100 mLU/mL (evidence of a sufficient vaccination response)
2. Hepatitis A:
 - two vaccinations **OR**
 - Proof of sufficient immunity in the blood
3. Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis, polio
 - last vaccination of the basic immunization within the last 10 years **OR**
 - last booster vaccination within the last 10 years
4. Chickenpox
 - two vaccinations **OR**
 - Proof of sufficient immunity in the blood
5. Mumps
 - two vaccinations
6. Rubella
 - two vaccinations for women
 - one vaccination for men

7. Influenza / Flu
 - current influenza/flu vaccination
8. TBE 7 (Baden-Württemberg is a risk area)
 - Basic immunization and booster vaccinations according to professional information
9. Hepatitis C and HIV Antibody screening
10. Tuberculosis-Test [e.g. quantiferon or tuberculin skin test]
