

- Contact a supervisor/group independently
 - Look for a suitable professor at the University
 - Get informed about their research – are you a fit?
 - Funding will probably not be offered. You will need to look for scholarships

✓ **Look for a funding opportunity**

What you will need:

- Letter of acceptance of the host supervisor
- Language proficiency test
- Submit a project with a clear plan for the exchange period

It is important to have prior contact with the host supervisor!

- **Humboldt Research Fellowship**
- postdoctoral researchers, experienced researchers
- all countries (excluding Germany)
- 6–24-month research stay in Germany
- **Deadline**
- The Selection Committee responsible for examining applications for this programme meets every March, July and November. It is recommended that applications be submitted well in advance of the desired selection date. Applications are usually processed within four to eight months.


