Heritage under Fire. The European Discourses of Heritage Preservation in the Middle East between WWI and Now

Zoya Masoud (BEYONDREST – Forum Transregionale Studien) and Dr. Sebastian Willert (Dubnow Institute)

An important consideration in heritage protection is the selective preservation of historical artifacts and architectural monuments. In the Middle East, colonial definitions of heritage and the practice of its preservation are still present. We emphasize the role of wars as catalysts in shaping disciplinary and social discourses about the past. By juxtaposing snapshots of such topographies of monument preservation during World War I and the recent war in Syria, we examine the modalities of preserving the past under fire and discuss them as resources for the construction of memory and identity(ies).
