Dr. Yoon Kyong Lee is a Sociologist of Migration Studies, with a focus in Korean migration, overseas Korean communities, return migrations to Korea, and North Korean issues.

She has conducted research in various regions and fields, including the United Nations, Population Division; the International Organization for Migration, IOM Korea Mission; and, with fellowships from the Korean and Chinese governments, in New York and New Jersey, U.S.A., as well as the greater Chinese region including Taiwan. For this winter semester, while teaching at Tübingen University as a guest professor, she expands her research interest to Europe, in particular the comparison and transformation of contemporary overseas Korean communities in Germany and the UK.
