NEW DEVELOPMENTS AND OPPORTUNITIES

HOME VISIT PROGRAM

International students are invited to visit homes of Kansai Gaidai local students or neighborhood on weekends and/or holidays to experience family life in Japan first-hand. The objectives of this program is to provide students with an opportunity to meet with local families to facilitate their immersion in Japan. Activities may include but are not limited to cooking Japanese cuisines, attending local festivals, and engaging in everyday family routines. Both students and families can enrich their lives through cross-cultural interactions.



ONLINE SUMMER PROGRAM

The Online Summer Program is a short, but effective means to begin Japanese language studies and/or learn about Japan and its culture. All courses are taught by experienced faculty members who are willing to share knowledge from their expertise through accelerated instruction.

To help experience interactions with local students, student-driven events are offered during the Program.



INTERCULTURAL ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM

(IEP)

This is a new semester based initiative created during the Covid-19 pandemic. The Intercultural Engagement Program is operated solely by students who are willing to take leadership in organizing and offering various opportunities to enhance interactions between local and international students.
