Organizational chart

Here you will find the organizational structure of the university's entire administration.

Alma:

<u>Alma</u> has been the new portal for applying to degree programs and managing courses at the University of Tübingen since the summer semester of 2020.

Procurement:

For various types of purchases, <u>Department VII, Section 3</u> is responsible. There may also be designated contacts within departments/institutes—these must be observed without exception.

Corporate Design:

To ensure a consistent visual identity for the university, numerous <u>templates</u> are available on the intranet (login ID required; see "E-Mail-Account"). For questions, please contact the University's <u>Public Relations Office</u>.

Employee ID Card:

You can apply for a <u>staff chip card</u>, which is needed for services like library access or the cafeteria. Note that there may be specific responsibilities within departments/institutes that must be followed.



Business Travel:

Travel requests must be submitted to the Dean (or to the Institute Director in self-managed institutes). Reimbursement is handled by the departments/institutes. Forms and more information can be found via Department VI under "Business Travel."

Email Account:

IT infrastructure is managed by the "Zentrum für Datenverarbeitung" (ZDV), which also handles email account applications. There may be relevant procedures within your department/institute that must be followed.

Family Office:

Provides <u>support</u> on balancing family responsibilities with studying, academic work, and professional life at the university.

Research Funding / Grant Consulting:

For help with <u>applying for research grants</u>, please contact Department II, Section 2. The "<u>Tü-bingen Research Funding News</u>" offers an overview of currently available grants and research prizes, and can also be subscribed to via an RSS feed for subject-specific updates. <u>The Research Database</u> provides an overview of ongoing externally funded projects.

The following tips are intended as suggestions and may not be complete.

What Tübingen has to offer

The city of Tübingen has compiled extensive information on various topics, including: Schools, Kindergartens, and Sports Clubs.

Additional services for families are provided by the Family Education Center.

Interesting activities and services from the university include: Botanical Garden, "Studium Generale", Children's University.

Excursion destinations

The <u>Swabian Alb</u>, with its <u>UNESCO Biosphere Reserve</u>, the <u>Zollernalb</u> (also offering themed, guided tours by "<u>Alb Guides</u>"), and the <u>Danube Valley</u> offer a wide range of leisure activities. From May to October, the <u>Bike-Hike Shuttle</u> lets you reach designated cycling and hiking trail networks on the Alb from Tübingen without needing a car.

In winter, the municipality of Sonnenbühl provides updates on current <u>winter sports</u> options on the Alb.

Other popular destinations include the <u>Panorama Spa</u> in Beuren, the castle ruins of "<u>Teck</u>" and "<u>Hohen Neuffen</u>", <u>Hohenzollern Castle</u>, <u>Lichtenstein Castle</u>, and – within walking distance from Tübingen – Hohenentringen Castle.

North of Tübingen is the large <u>Schönbuch Nature Park</u>, featuring the impressive Bebenhausen <u>Monastery</u> complex.

The website Schönbuch und Heckengäu also offers many suggestions.

Of the more than 2,000 caves known in the Swabian Alb, the most beautiful and interesting are open to visitors as show caves.

Popular local recreation areas include <u>Lake Constance</u> and the <u>Black Forest</u>.

Cultural Activites

You can find information about theater, museums, music events, and Tübingen's diverse cultural scene online.

A special highlight of the city's <u>church music</u> is the Tübinger Motette, a weekly event that has accompanied the church calendar's themes and festivals with spiritual music and liturgy for 65 years.

The cultural program of the state capital Stuttgart, including the award-winning Stuttgart Opera House (one of the <u>State Theaters of Stuttgart</u>), is a great addition to what Tübingen offers.
