Specification/Project title: How Emotional Experiences and Entertainment Shaped Natural Knowledge: Antiquarian Collecting and Knowledge Network in Early Modern China

Topic Description: With the "global turn" in the history of science, increasing efforts have been made to explore the production of scientific knowledge in non-European regions and the interactions between knowledge centers and peripheral regions. The new focus of this project, is on how antiquarian collecting in early modern China, infused with curiosity, imagination, and anxieties, previously regarded as a reaction against the positivism influenced by Neo-Confucianism since the 11th century, contributed to the production of natural knowledge.
