Flat funding rates for travel support and additional travel days

Flat funding rates for travel support

The calculation of the travel distance for the travel support is based on the <u>Erasmus+</u> <u>Distance Calculator</u> (one-way distance from Tübingen to the host institution).

| Distance band | Standard Travel | Green Travel |
|-----------------|-----------------|--------------|
| 10 to 99 KM | 23 € | 23 € |
| 100 to 499 KM | 180 € | 210 € |
| 500 to 1999 KM | 275 € | 320 € |
| 2000 to 2999 KM | 360 € | 410 € |
| 3000 to 3999 KM | 530 € | 610 € |
| 4000 to 7999 KM | 820 € | 820 € |
| 8000 KM or more | 1500 € | 1500 € |

The general guideline is that participants should travel less than 500 km by sustainable means of transport (e.g. train, bus). This is an appeal from the European Commission to all participants, but it is not an obligation. Travel is considered sustainable if at least 50% of the distance is done by using sustainable means of transport.

Travel days according to demand/necessity

- In case of travel by non-sustainable means of transport, a maximum of 2 additional travel days can be granted as required.
- In case of travel by sustainable means of transport, a total of up to 6 additional travel days can be granted as required.

The additional travel days do not count towards the eligible minimum or maximum duration of the mobility. Please note the reduced funding rates as of the 15th mobility day. Travel days count as mobility days for this purpose.
