Mun-Yeong Ahn received his Ph.D. in German Literature from the University of Bonn, BRD. He then worked at Chungnam National University in Daejeon, Republic of Korea, where he is currently an Emeritus Professor. He has led the Korean Association of German Studies (KGG), the Korean Goethe-Association, and the Humboldt-Club Korea. He has also led the Translation Research Institute of German and Korean Literature, where presently he takes responsibility for publication of the Seon-Kwang Korean-German Dictionary.



As part of the lecture series, Mun-Yeong Ahn will introduce aspects of Rilke reception in South Korea. He will consider three points of view for discussion: Korean translations, academic researches, and literary influences on the Korean poets. Some representative names will be mentioned in connection to these points of view.
