- Introduction of income-based fee scales for KiKo places (university places in municipal childcare facilities).
- Establishment of KITA Lingua, a language and orientation program specifically for people with a migrant background who wish to become childcare workers or social education assistants, as a measure to combat the shortage of skilled workers.
