
## Formatting and Style Guide:

This is a formatting guide for using the style sheet in the 11th bwHPC Symposium Proceedings template. If you have any questions about accessing the styles, please refer to the brief usage table included in the document.



## **Styles Usage Table:**

Style Sheet items	Usage / Examples
1Paper Title	Title; Subtitle
2Author Style	Author names; affiliations
3Abstract	Abstract header style
4Keywords	Keywords section
Body Text	Apply this format to the first paragraph following each heading or subheading.  Paragraphs that come after blank lines, headings, images, or bullet points should start without indentation. Please use the 'Body Text' style.
Body Text (Indent)	Use this style for the second, third, and all subsequent paragraphs under each heading or subheading. These paragraphs should begin with an indent. Apply the 'Body Text (Indent)' style and avoid inserting blank lines or extra spaces, as the formatting is designed to apply the correct spacing.
Body Text - Capitalized	To highlight text within body text (using ALL CAPS)
Body Text - Italic	To highlight text within body text (using italics)
Code	For code snippets and equations
Endnote Text	Formatting for EndNote under References
Figure - Placeholder	Placeholder for images
Footnote	For footnotes
Header	For all main headers in the proceedings (except the abstract header)
Header (Sub)	For all sub-headers in the proceedings
Table Placeholder	Placeholder for tables
