

## Important Information about the UNlcert® III Oral Exam (Business *English* / *Beruf und Studium*)



### A. Text selection

The UNlcert® III Business English oral exam is based on two texts, chosen by the examinee from a pool of texts, which serve as the basis for discussion between the examinee and two examiners.

After exam registration, you will be sent a link to ILIAS with a folder which contains a pool of articles for possible oral exam topics. You need to select two topics and inform Rachel Thoma, at the latest two weeks before the written exam, which two topics you have chosen ([rachel.thoma@uni-tuebingen.de](mailto:rachel.thoma@uni-tuebingen.de)).

### B. The oral exam procedure

- The oral exam lasts 30 minutes (approximately 15 minutes per text), and is carried out individually.
- The exam is a discussion with two examiners (members of the English Department) on your two texts, not a presentation. You will be guided with questions by the examiners on and around the two topics to facilitate the discussion, foster interaction and to test your ability to communicate naturally and fluently.
- You are not allowed to use any supplementary material in the exam; no copies of the texts, no notes, no power point slides.
