#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

For hundreds of years, Europe had suffered the tragedy of war many times before 1945. In particular, the center of the conflict was France and Germany in modern times. ECSC (European Coal and Steel Community), established in 1952 inspired by the "Schumann Declaration (Link is external)" which advocated the foundation of the mechanism of supranational Europe in 1950, was a starting point of present EU (European Union). In this lecture, while looking down at European countries, the first half focuses on looking back upon the pace of the EU, which is a regional integration affiliated with twenty-seven countries, and exceeding 450 million people. The second half concentrates on explaining the cultural and social histories and the present situations beyond the various histories, cultures, and social structures of European countries using the visualization based on statistical survey data. Main contents contain diverse aspects such as "Family and changing gender roles", "Religion", "Work orientation", "National identity & Citizenship", "Role of government", "Social inequality" and "Environment" etc. At the very end of this lecture, we will discuss the essential issues such as what the EU is like. How has the EU been developing? What kind of social implications does the EU provide?
