Course title	Effective Leadership
Course content	Effective leadership involves guiding, inspiring, and influencing others to achieve common goals and drive organizational success. It's about more than just managing tasks; it requires clear communication, strategic thinking, emotional intelligence, and the ability to motivate and empower team members. In this course, we will analyze different styles of leadership and discuss case studies and articles relating to the worlds of sports, business and education.
Learning objectives	(1) recognizing effective leadership (2) become familiar with different styles of leadership (3) understanding the 'team' (4) increase cultural awareness. By the end of the course you should be more confident to lead others yourself.
Method of instruction	Intercultural virtual exchange. Student driven discussions. Classes will be taught via ZOOM (90 min/week) and MOODLE (content management system of Tübingen University (45min/wk).
Academic hours	2 hours/week on Zoom + 1 hour/week on learning platform.
Course requirements	Advanced English skills, written and oral.
