Course title	A Digital Wolof Beginner's Class
Course content	<p>The course will cover all aspects of Wolof needed for conversations and communication routines needed in everyday life. Lessons are lively and communicative connecting intense language training with general knowledge of Wolof in Senegal and West Africa.</p> <p>Level of this class: Elementary Wolof I (European Framework of reference: A1)</p>
Learning objectives	<p>At the end of the Course, students will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Communicate in the Wolof Language; - Develop communicative skills in variety of topics such as: Meeting people, social events, health, schedules, cultural notes, etc ...
Method of instruction	<p>Distance learning; Classes will be taught via Zoom.</p>
Academic hours	2 hours/week on Zoom + 1 hour/week on learning platform
Course requirements	Anyone who is interested in learning Wolof can take part in this course as it is for beginners.
Credits & Grading	<p>4 ECTS</p> <p>Regular attendance, 3 graded assignments, including at least one oral grade. <i>(For BA Minor African Literary & Cultural Studies, 6 ECTS can be awarded in relation to the greater workload)</i></p>
