Transport is cheap and easy

Wollongong is close to Sydney – just 90 minutes by road or train.

Free Buses

Wollongong is well-connected with buses going to all of the surrounding suburbs.

Free 'city loop' buses run all day and into the night, making it easy for you to travel from campus and student accommodation to the city centre, train station and shopping district.

North Wollongong Station is a 15-minute walk or a short free shuttle bus ride from our Wollongong campus.

Cost

For any public transport in and between Wollongong and Sydney, you'll never pay more than \$17.80 a day or \$50 a week. Travel on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays is \$8.90.*

Top 5 things to do in Wollongong
