“Experimental Economics: Theory & Evidence”

The colloquium is part of the M.Sc.-Program in Management & Economics. Depending on available spots, a limited number of students from other programs will also be admitted to the course. Concerning creditability on the different programs, please see below.

Participants of the course are required to present one research paper that will be assigned within the kick-off-meeting (15 minutes). Further and following the kick-off meeting, every course participant will be assigned to an additional short presentation (5 minutes) that centers around a topic related to the research paper presented by a fellow student. In addition, we reserve about 15 minutes discussion for every research paper.

Criteria for the grading are (a) self-dependence in preparing the presentations, (b) clarity and persuasiveness of the presentations, and (c) taking an active part in the discussions.

Students who are interested in participating need to apply via ALMA until **Friday, February 7, 2025**. Registration via ALMA will be open starting from February 1, 2025.

All participants are **required to attend the kick-off meeting on Monday, April 14, 2025 at 4.00 p.m. sharp**. Attending the kick-off meeting is mandatory for taking part in the colloquium. During the kick-off meeting, research papers will be assigned to participants. Additional short presentations will be assigned following the kick-off meeting.

Note that participants **need to attend both presentation days**. The exact time schedule on the two presentation days depends on the number of participants and will be announced at a later point in time. Until then, make sure you completely reserve both presentation days.
