Specification/Project title: Cultural Contacts between the Late Classic/Hellenistic world and the

Eurasian steppe from an archaeological perspective

Topic Description: The project should examine the cultural interactions between the later

Classical/Hellenistic Greek world (4th–1st centuries BCE) and the nomadic societies of the Eurasian Steppe, with a focus on three interconnected contact zones: the Northern Black Sea and Pontic–Caspian Steppe, the Central Asian region from the Caspian–Aral basin to Bactria, and the Mongolian Steppe. Drawing upon archaeological evidence, classical literary sources, the project seeks to provide a comparative synthesis that moves beyond regional

isolation in current scholarship.
