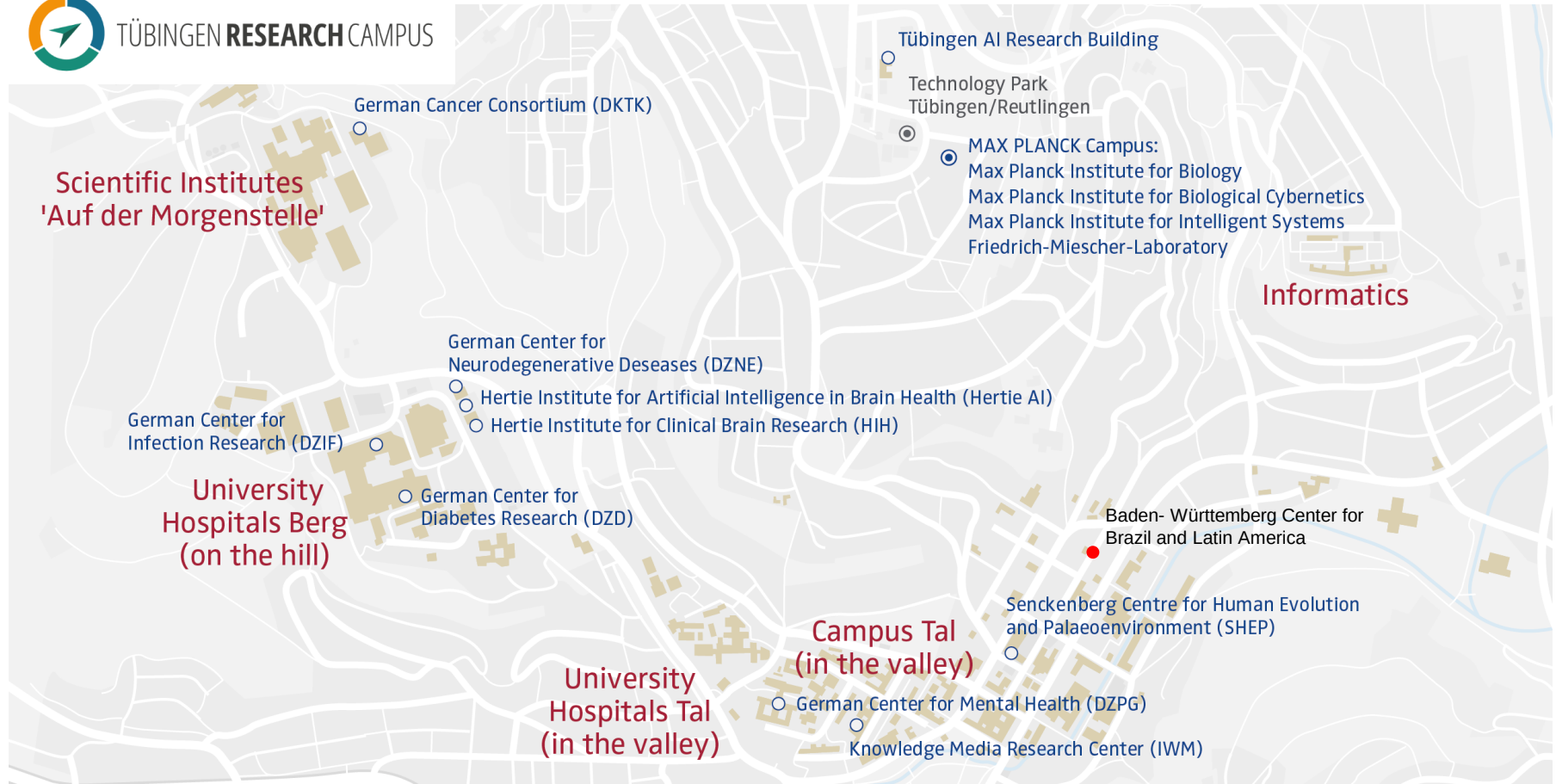




Tübingen campuses and key extra-university partners

- Contact a supervisor/group independently
 - Look for a suitable professor at the University
 - Get informed about their research – are you a fit?
 - Funding will probably not be offered. You will need to look for scholarships

✓ **Look for a funding opportunity**

What you will need:

- Letter of acceptance of the host supervisor
- Language proficiency test
- Submit a project with a clear plan for the exchange period

It is important to have prior contact with the host supervisor!

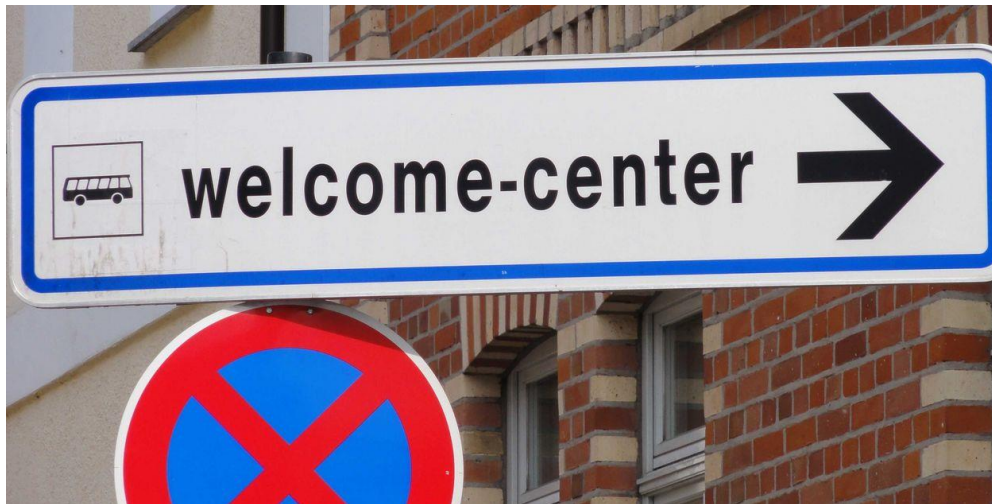

DAAD– Doctoral Scholarship Program in Germany

Doctoral Programme

Up to 4 years

Complete execution and
defense of the thesis in
Germany.



Bi-nationally Supervised Doctoral Degrees / Cotutelle

Up to 24 months

One-Year Grants for Doctoral Candidates

DAAD Funding Possibilities for Postdocs

Establishing a long-term career in Germany

PRIME | Postdoctoral Researchers International Mobility Experience

Funded by the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) and the European Union (EU/FP7/Marie Curie Actions/COFUND).

The funding is granted for 18 months, of which 12 months must be spent abroad and 6 months (reintegration phase) at a German university. The reintegration phase is mandatory.

Open for applications: May 2025
Application deadline: 30 August 2025
Selection: February 2026

Looking for funding

- **Humboldt Research Fellowship**
 - postdoctoral researchers, experienced researchers
 - all countries (excluding Germany)
 - 6–24-month research stay in Germany
- **Deadline**
 - The Selection Committee responsible for examining applications for this program meets every March, July and November. It is recommended that applications be submitted well in advance of the desired selection date. Applications are usually processed within four to eight months.

- **Application Options for Post-doctoral Researchers**
 - Participation as a Post-doctoral Researcher in a DFG Research Project or Group
 - Participation in a Workshop for Early Career Investigators
- **Individual Funding to Support Research Careers**
 - Starting a Research Career: the Walter Benjamin Program
 - Leading an Independent Junior Research Group under the Emmy Noether Program
 - En Route to a Professorship under the Heisenberg Program
- **Other Submission Options for Project Funding**
 - Your Research Project under the Research Grant
 - Scientific Networks
 - Initiation of International Collaboration
