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**TEA-lectureships *Gender Studies*
winter semester 2026/27**

Dear members of the Humanities Faculty,

The Equal Opportunities Commission is offering lectureships for the **winter semester 2026/27** for classes with a clear focus on *gender studies* or topics that particularly highlight the role of women. Lectureships are preferentially given to departments in which these topics have so far been less prominent.

Potential lecturers can apply in consultation with the departments. The lectureships are paid at €50 per teaching period of 45 minutes from the University's Teaching Equality (TEA) program. Additionally, up to €580 in travel funds are available, which can be either for the lecturer's travel to the class or for guest lectures (fee and travel expenses) in the context of the seminar. The aim is to enable young academics to have the opportunity to invite a renowned specialist to give a lecture as part of the course. This would need to be well motivated and offer a clear advantage for the course participants. Such a guest lecture should also be accessible for other university members to the class participants.

Applications should be submitted by e-mail to gleichstellung@philosophie.uni-tuebingen.de. The deadline for submission is 1 July 2026. The application must include a brief CV of the applicant and a one-page description of the requested course, highlighting the gender or women's focus, defining the learning objectives, describing the type of course (lecture, seminar, etc.), and estimating the expected number of participants. Applications should be accompanied by a short letter from a university professor at the relevant institute endorsing the project. If travel expenses are requested, a justification and a cost breakdown are required.
