Luiz Carlos Bombassaro earned his M.A. in Philosophy from the Federal University of Rio Grande do Sul (UFRGS) in 1990 and pursued doctoral and postdoctoral studies in Philosophy at the Universities of Heidelberg (1993) and Kaiserslautern (2001), Germany.

A Full Professor at UFRGS, he has built a distinguished academic career dedicated to teaching, research, and university administration.

He began his teaching career at the University of Caxias do Sul in 1983 and subsequently served as a professor in the Department of Philosophy at the Federal University of Paraná



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Since 1996, he has been a faculty member at UFRGS, where he also served as Coordinator of the Research Ethics Committee.

His academic work focuses on Philosophy, Epistemology, Ethics, Renaissance Philosophy, and Philosophy of Education. His principal research interests include the works of Giordano Bruno, the history of science and the Copernican Revolution, as well as interdisciplinarity and conceptual change in educational processes.

Throughout his career, he has published books, book chapters, and articles on epistemology, history of science, philosophy of education, and Renaissance philosophy. Among his major works are *The Boundaries of Epistemology: How Knowledge Is Produced*, *Science and Conceptual Change*, and *Giordano Bruno and Philosophy in the Renaissance*. He has also edited numerous academic volumes in collaboration with Brazilian and international scholars.
