Applications for funding from the Equal Opportunity Committee

The Faculty Equality Opportunity Committee has its own funds for promoting equality and diversity. This includes both the promotion of individuals with a connection to equality or diversity and research-related activities that deal with these aspects.

The Faculty Equality Opportunity Committee, which includes representatives from both departments and all institutes, decides on the applications. When applying, it is necessary to contact the representative of the institute or department on the Equality Opportunity Committee. Purpose and target group

The funding is intended to promote equality and diversity at the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences. Students, doctoral candidates, and faculty members (mid-level) are eligible to apply.

Criteria for application approval

Subject-related criteria:

1. The applicant must have a connection to equality and/or diversity (e.g., female gender, caregiving responsibilities, migration history, disability, LGBTQIA connection, first-generation academic, etc.).
2. Activities that deal with the above-mentioned or related aspects can be funded without the applicant having to meet these criteria themselves.
3. The relevant connection must be clear from the application.
4. The activity eligible for funding must be of practical use to the applicant in terms of research and/or teaching or serve the purpose of further training.

Formale criteria:

1. Please use the form "Application for funding from the Equal Opportunities Committee of the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences" and submit the completed application.
2. Adherence to deadlines: Please submit your application **at least 2 weeks prior** to the start of the activity to be funded.
3. A maximum of one application per year per applicant.

Application process

Applications must be sent by email to gleichstellung@wiso.uni-tuebingen.de. **Only applications submitted in electronic form can be processed.**

Obligation to report

After completion of the funded activity, a written report (**max. half a page**) must be submitted.

Funding opportunities

Here you will find the maximum funding amounts awarded by the Equal Opportunity Committee:

Conference participation (with active contribution, domestic)	300
Conference participation (with active contribution, international)	400
Conference participation without active contribution (students only)	300
Research project (Auxiliary staff/material costs)	400
Structural measures (e.g., childcare)	300
Funds for nursing/caregiving duties	600
Other equality/diversity measures	300

Payments

If you have been granted funds by the Equal Opportunity Committee, please note the following when reporting expenses. The application for reimbursement of expenses must be submitted to the **Dean's Office of the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences**.

1. For the reimbursement of expenses, please send the original documents to the Dean's Office, Finance Department, Nauklerstr. 48, 72074 Tübingen:
 - Informal letter requesting reimbursement of expenses from the Equal Opportunity Committee,
 - Letter of approval,
 - **Half-page report** (see obligation to report) reflecting on and evaluating the benefits or success of the funded activity,
 - List of expenses plus original receipts (e.g., train tickets, hotel bill, participation fee),
 - Your home address,
 - Your bank details (or cost account if pre-financed by the chair),
 - Your date of birth,
 - **For employees of the University of Tübingen:** Travel authorization.
