Prof. Dr. Rui Vicente Oppermann

Graduated in Dentistry from the Federal University of Rio Grande do Sul (UFRGS) in 1974 and earned a Ph.D. in Dentistry from the University of Oslo, Norway, in 1980. He has been a Full Professor at the UFRGS School of Dentistry since 1983 and currently serves as Director of International Relations at Capes. He previously served as Dean of the School of Dentistry (2004–2007), Vice President (Vice-Rector) of UFRGS (2008–2016), and President (Rector) of UFRGS (2016–2020). Although re-elected for a second term, he was not appointed by former President Jair Bolsonaro.



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He is a Research Fellow of Brazil's National Council for Scientific and Technological Development (CNPq), a member of the Board of Directors and Coordinator of the International Relations Committee of ANDIFES (the Brazilian National Association of Federal Higher Education Institutions), a member of the Academic Committee of ENLACES (the Latin American and Caribbean Higher Education Area), and Coordinator of the UFRGS initiative for the 2018 Regional Conference on Higher Education (CRES 2018).

His work focuses on higher education at both national and international levels, including public policy for higher education; higher education systems in Brazil, Latin America and the Caribbean, Africa, Europe, and English-speaking countries; traditional and solidarity-based internationalization of higher education; and multilateral international cooperation in higher education.

Since 2020, he has published articles and book chapters on higher education policy.
